Opportunity Inc. of Palm Beach County recently received a five-plus-star rating through the Quality Counts rating improvement system for early care and education providers.

Opportunity Inc., the oldest charity organization in the county, has been serving Palm Beach County children for more than 71 years.

It is designed to offer low-cost, quality preschool child care, educational programming and parent support to low-income families, single-parent families and families in crisis.

Quality Counts uses a five-star method to ensure quality standards so that children enter school eager and ready to learn.

The rating is based on these standards: learning environment, staff-to-child ratio/group sizes, family engagement, curriculum, administration and staff qualifications/professional development.
